**Tip Sheets** Trade: Transportation Heavy Haul Controls Placement Cab Use Job Task: **General Tasks Common Tools** Truck Driving Control levers, knobs and pedals that are common to a semi-truck cab **Potential Risk Factors Possible Solutions** Risk Factors can lead to increased risk for Work Related Awkward Posture Solutions: Musculoskeletal Disorders (WMSD's) Ensure that seat is adjusted to proper reach requirements for interior dash and gear shifter controls Moderate Forward Back Bending As needed consider adding extensions for clutch, Depending on seat and control placement brake and fuel pedals to ensure proper support of the bending at the waist and increased reach may lower legs and reduce force requirements to engage be needed if not properly adjusted to the the foot controls drivers height and reach requirements. Shoulder, arm, and hand overreaching beyond **Potential Benefits** relaxed neutral postures Reduces reach requirements allowing for neutral When controls are not properly adjusted the relaxed shoulder, arm and hand postures. increased stretching and reach may cause Reduces exertion of lower back. added stress and discomfort on the shoulder, Increases blood flow to reduce muscle tension. arms and hands Feasibility **Engineer Control** Foot pedal extensions, gear shift extensions Work Practice Control Administrative Control

## **Estimated Cost of Intervention**

• \$300-500 for pedal extensions plus installation. Gear shift extension \$10-\$50 plus installation
